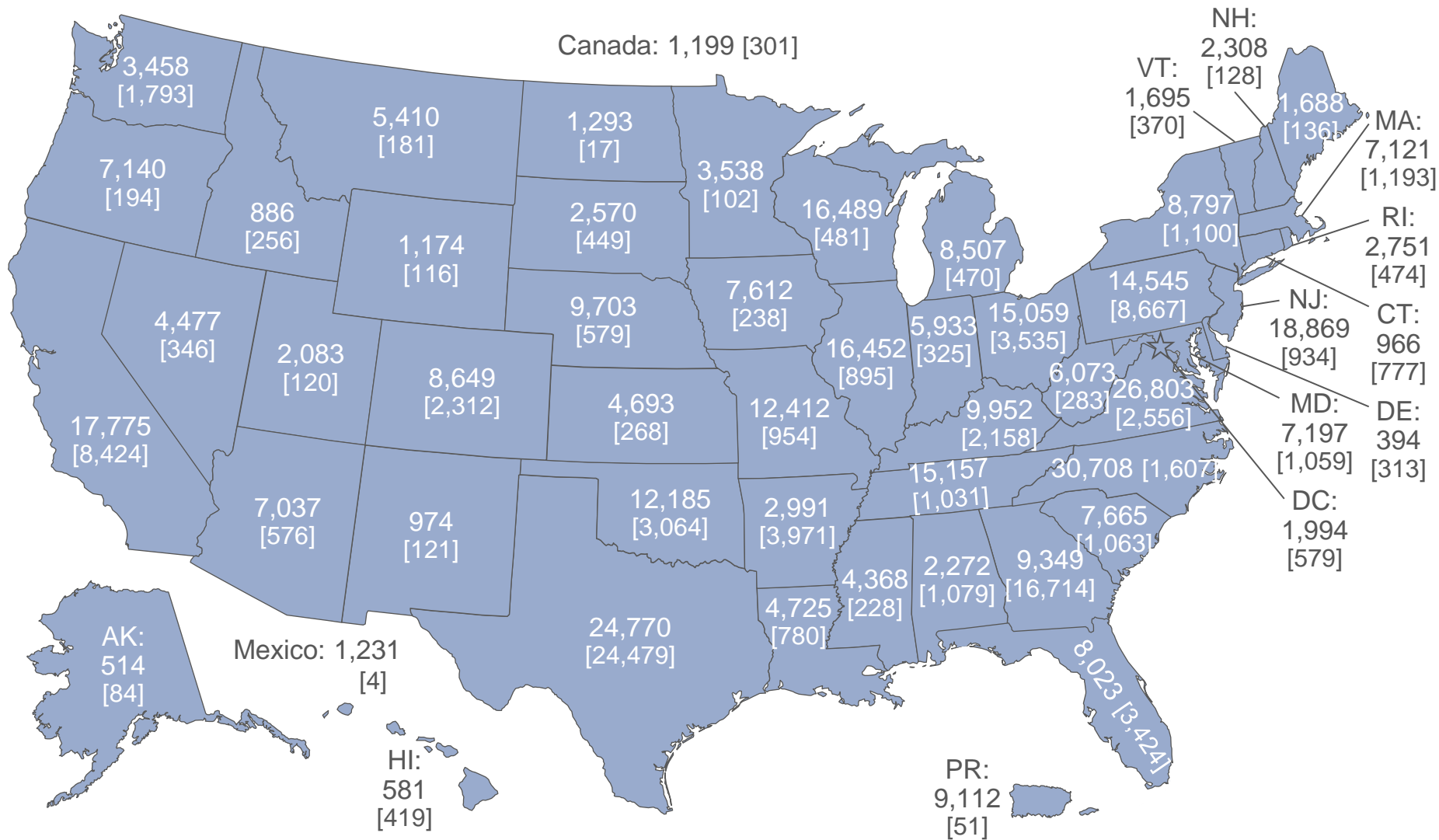

- As of April 12, 2021

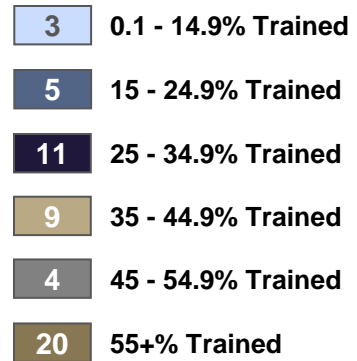
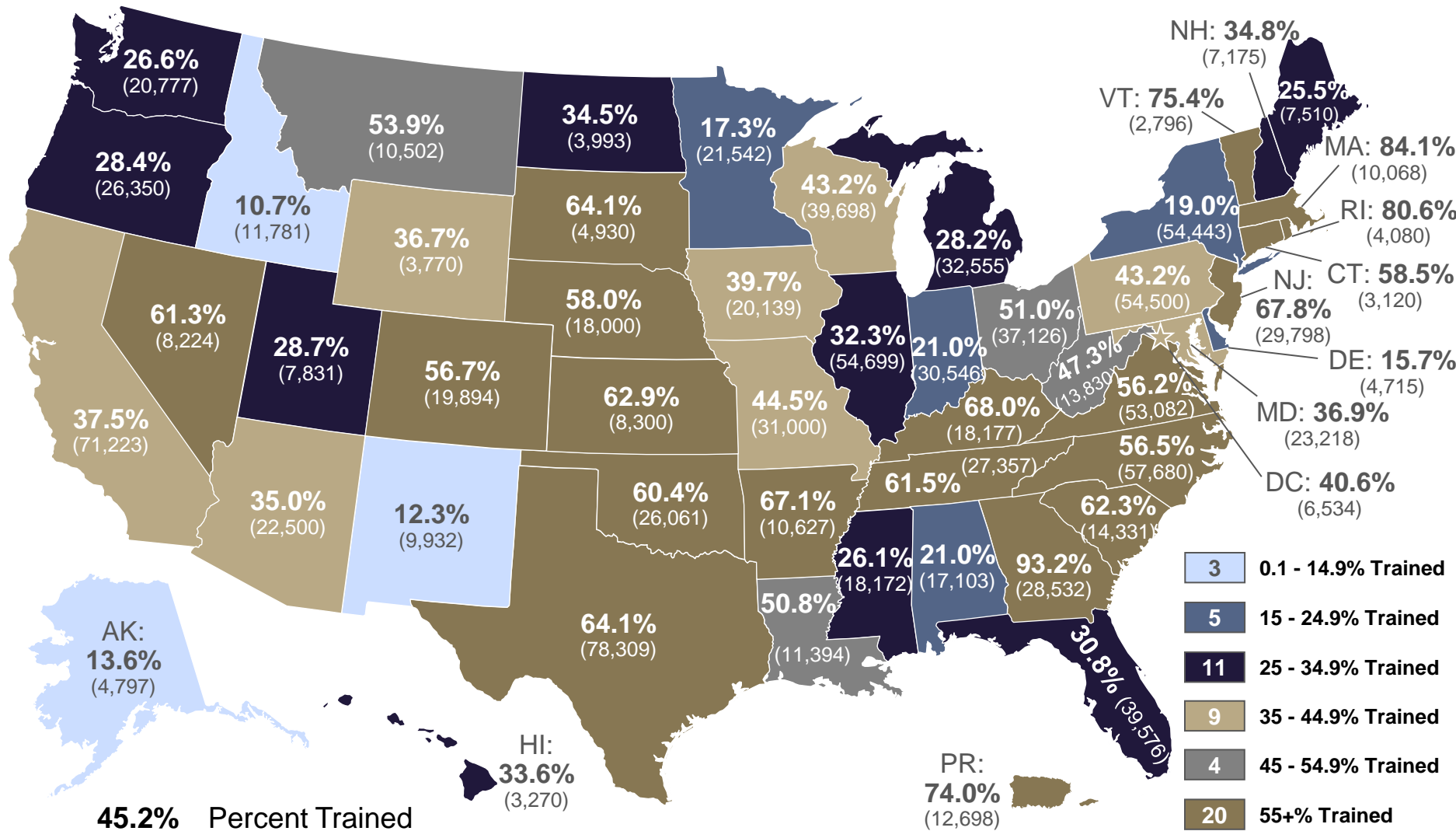


Number of Responders Trained: In-Person - **409,327** Web-Based Training (WBT) - **[101,778]**

- As of April 12, 2021



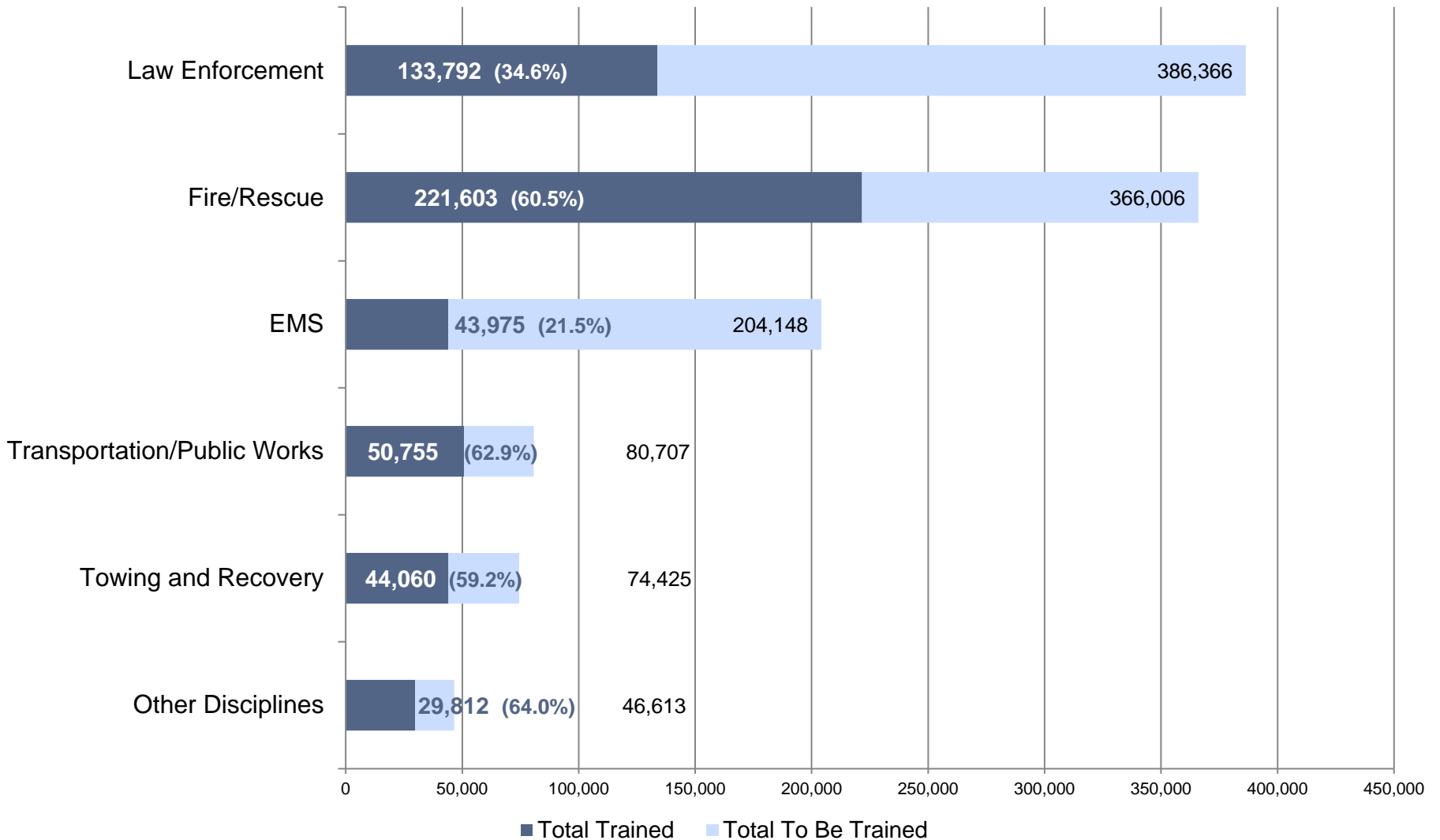
