#### **AZ TIM COALITION BACKGROUND**

- FORMED IN 2010 FOLLOWING THE "ADVANCED TRAFFIC INCIDENT MANAGEMENT WORKSHOP, EXECUTIVE SESSION" CONDUCTED IN NOVEMBER 16-17, 2010.
- A CHARTER WAS DRAFTED AND LATER SIGNED BY PARTICIPATING AGENCY'S WHICH ADMINISTRATIVELY
  PLACED THE COALITION UNDER THE UMBRELLA OF AZTECH, A REGIONAL TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT
  PARTNERSHIP IN THE PHOENIX METROPOLITAN AREA.
  - WHILE ADMINISTRATIVELY REGIONAL, CORE TEAM MEMBERSHIP HAS INCLUDED AZDOT, AZDPS, APTRA
    (TOWING) AND DHS (EMS) WHICH OPERATIONALLY PROVIDED FOR STATEWIDE COVERAGE.
  - COALITION IS CHAIRED BY DPS AND LED BY CORE TEAM MEMBERS FROM THE TIM DISCIPLINES
- THE AZ TIM COALITION HAS AND CONTINUES TO HOLD REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETINGS BI-MONTHLY WITH VARIOUS AD-HOC MEETINGS AS NEEDED. https://tim.az.gov/



#### AZ TIM COALITION AWARDS SUBCOMMITTEE

- THE COALITION FORMED AN AWARDS SUBCOMMITTEE TO DEVELOP A RECOGNITION PROGRAM IN 2019.
- REPRESENTATION FROM DOT, DPS, DHS, FHWA, AND TOWING SIT ON THE AWARDS COMMITTEE
  - IT CONSIST OF 7 MEMBERS, INCLUDING THE AZ TIM COALITION CHAIR OR PROXY
    - OTHER MEMBERS SELECTED FROM A VARIETY OF DISCIPLINES
    - ODD NUMBER TO ELIMINATE TIES IN THE SELECTION PROCESS
- THIS WAS DRIVEN IN PART THROUGH FHWA-STIC FUNDS TO DEVELOP A "TRAFFIC INCIDENT MANAGEMENT CHALLENGE PROGRAM. THE AZ TIM CHALLENGE COIN IS DEPICTED IN A LATER SLIDE.

# **PROCESS**

- ESTABLISH GUIDELINES TO BE ELIGIBLE
- DIFFERENT CATEGORIES
- COINS AND CERTIFICATES MINIMUM AWARD
- PLAQUES ARE ADDITIONAL FOR
  - AWARDED TO LIFETIME AND ANNUAL ACHIEVEMENT RECIPIENTS
  - AND GOLD AND SILVER TRAINER RECIPIENTS

#### **5 AWARD CATEGORIES AND FORM- EXAMPLE**

- LIFE TIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD
- ANNUAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARD
- TRAINING ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS
  - GOLD 50 CLASSES/500 STUDENTS
  - SILVER 25 CLASSES/250 STUDENTS
  - BRONZE 10 CLASSES/ 100 STUDENTS



#### **NOMINATIONS**

- LIFETIME AND ANNUAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS ARE NOMINATED BY AGENCIES AND/OR PEERS.
- TRAINING AWARDS ARE BASED ON TRAINING NUMBERS ENTERED IN THE FHWA NATIONAL DATABASE USING THE BIWEEKLY REPORTS THAT ARE SENT OUT TO THE STATE TIM CONTACTS.
  - THIS ALSO PROVIDES AN INCENTIVE FOR INSTRUCTORS TO INPUT THEIR CLASS ROSTERS INTO THE FHWA DATABASE.
- IN 2019, AZ WILL BE AWARDING 10 TRAINING AWARDS OUT OF THE 71 INSTRUCTORS WHO HAVE BEEN ACTIVE.
  - 2 GOLD
  - 2 SILVER
  - AND 6 BRONZE
- 2019 ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS ARE PENDING-BUT EXPECTED THIS YEAR
- NOMINATIONS DURING THIS FIRST YEAR COVER A TIME PERIOD FROM 2012 TO PRESENT.

### SELECTION OF AWARD RECIPIENTS

- THE NOMINATIONS ARE REVIEWED BY THE AZ TIM AWARDS COMMITTEE
  - THE COMMITTEE DETERMINES IF THE ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS RISE TO THE LEVEL OF THE AWARD
    - ONLY ONE OF EACH WILL BE AWARDED EACH YEAR
    - IF THE COMMITTEE DOES NOT BELIEVE THERE IS A NOMINATION THAT RISES TO THE LEVEL OF EXPECTATION, THEY ARE NOT OBLIGATED TO AWARD IN A GIVEN YEAR.
  - TRAINING AWARD NOMINATIONS ARE SUBMITTED BY A MEMBER OF COMMITTEE STAFF USING THE NATIONAL DATABASE BUT CAN ALSO BE SUBMITTED BY AGENCIES OR PEERS.
    - NOMINATIONS FOR TRAINING AWARDS SUBMITTED BY AGENCY OR PEERS WILL BE VERIFIED USING THE NATIONAL TIM
      TRAINING DATABASE TO ASSURE ALL ROSTERS HAVE BEEN ENTERED.
    - IF A DISCREPANCY IN NUMBERS TRAINED IS FOUND, UPDATED ROSTERS WILL BE REQUESTED AND ENTERED INTO THE NATIONAL DATABASE PRIOR TO GRANTING THE AWARD.

#### **PRESENTATION**

- THE AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED TO **RECIPIENTS EACH YEAR DURING AN AZ** TIM AWARENESS WEEK EVENT.
  - THIS YEAR AZ IS HOSTING A MASS **TRAINING EVENT ON NOVEMBER 13, 2019.**
  - **DURING THAT EVENT THERE WILL ALSO BE** A MEDIA EVENT AND MANY AGENCY PIOS **WILL BE PRESENT.**
  - **THE 2019 AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED** AT THAT EVENT.
