

Why? Existing Local Agency Service Provider Opted out of their Contract. This Provided Opportunity to (What?):

- Focus on the Outcomes of the maintenance services instead of the processes in performing them.
- Tie into the MDOT Performance Based Maintenance Metrics (est. 2013): Michigan Maintenance Rating System (MiMRS)
- 3. Incorporate other Maintenance Best Practices and Technologies into Performance.

Timeline (When?):

- Sept 2018: County provided formal notice to end Services 10/1/2019
- March 2019: Decision made to proceed with performance based maintenance contract.
- October 1st, 2019: FAMS Contractor in place (Ferrovial) and performing maintenance work. (Three Year Contract with three one-year options)

Michigan Maintenance Rating System Handbook

PBM Data since 2013:

- 1. 22 asset/maintenance classifications
- Pass/Fail representative segments
- 3. Statewide ratings twice per year
- 4. Contract ratings quarterly and tied to performance penalties.





How? MiMRS



This pavement has significant cracking, but has been patched and should meet the performance measure.



This pavement has a wide crack which is improperly patched.


