About Commuter Choice


A competitive grant program that invests toll revenues from two Northern Virginia expressway corridors into transportation projects that benefit toll payers, in that they...



















Impacts: Tolling and Commuter Choice funding







Challenges we're working to address

Encourage diverse project proposals

• Likely nearing market saturation for new/expanded commuter bus routes even pre-COVID

Assist applicants in fostering strong, innovative project proposals

- More discussion about finding good fits with program requirements, less unguided "seeing what sticks"
- Encourage innovative technology solutions within the constraints of competitive procurement requirements

• Emphasize directly measurable outcomes
