



## **Recent Incidents Page**


- Automatically updated daily




This section provides an overview of **incident volume** in the San Francisco Bay Area, including incidents in the past day, month, and quarter.

## Shelter-in-Place Impact

 As incident volumes increase, median and 90th percentile clearance times are decreasing

• Median: 50 to 44 minutes

• **90th Percentile:** 180 to 131

minutes



# **Incident Clearance Times**

- Crashes were driving increase in clearance times through April
- Crash clearances times were down in June and July

5-Year Median Incident Clearance Time




#### 5-Year Median Clearance Time

 90th percentile clearance time is down from peak in April 2020






5-Year 90th Percentile Incident Clearance Times




