

Responder Struck-By Fatalities

SURVIVAL ALERT UPDATE

- The significant increase in the number of Responder Struck-By fatalities in 2019 as compared to 2018 is **alarming**
- **30** fatalities have occurred since January 1st:
 - 3 - Firefighters/EMS Personnel
 - 13 - Law Enforcement Officers
 - 12 - Towing & Recovery Personnel
 - 2 – Mobile Mechanics
 - 0 – DOT/SSP
 - 0 – DPW
 - 0 – Other

As well as untold injuries that have yet to be reported

National TIM Responder Training Program Implementation Progress

Train-the-Trainer Sessions

- 435 sessions with 12,248 participants
- 23% of participants have provided training

- 15,680 sessions with 359,170 participants

- 12,407 ERSI Responder Safety Learning Network

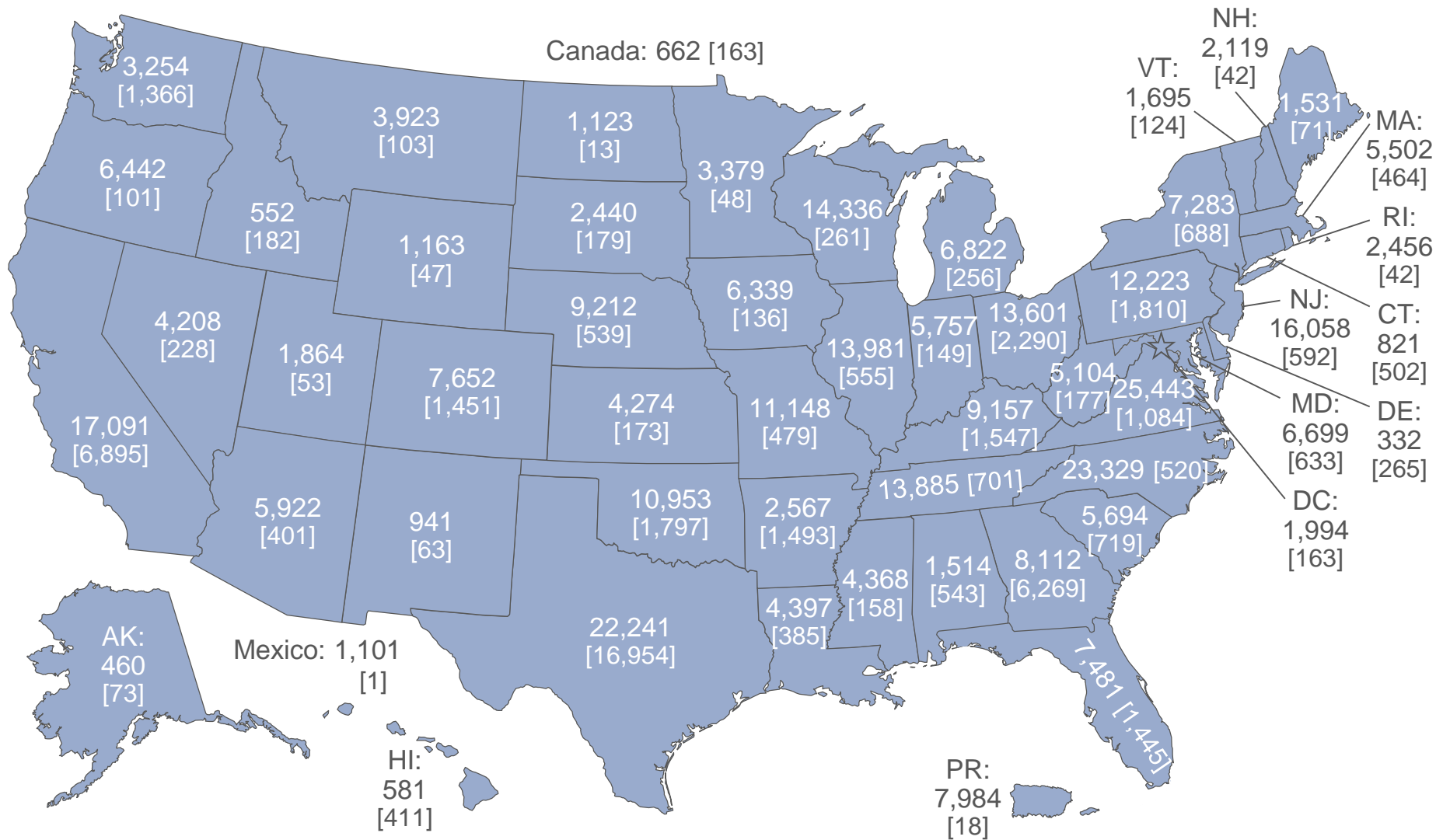

- As of August 26, 2019

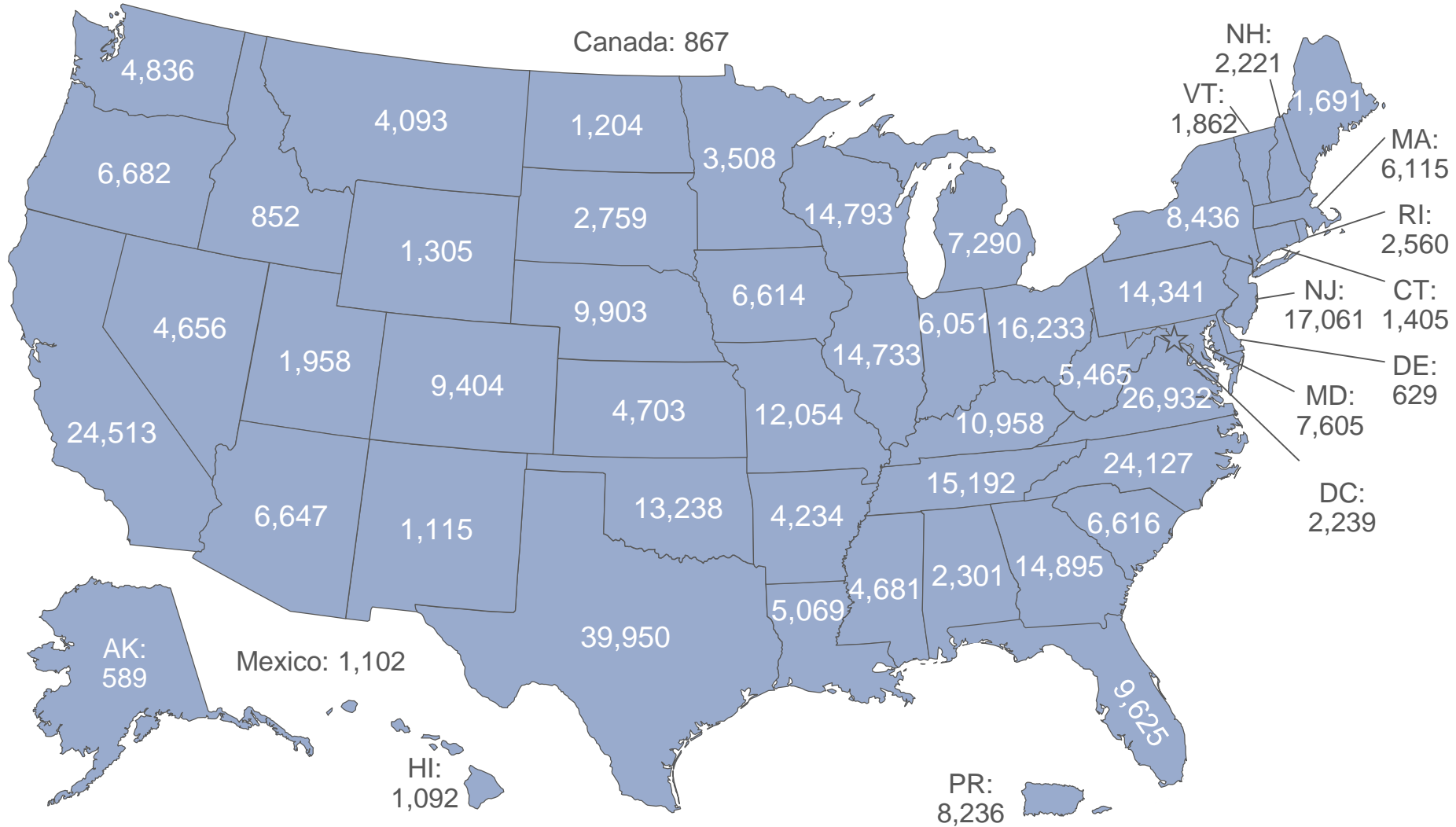


Number of Responders Trained: In-Person - **359,170** Web-Based Training (WBT) - **[55,822]**

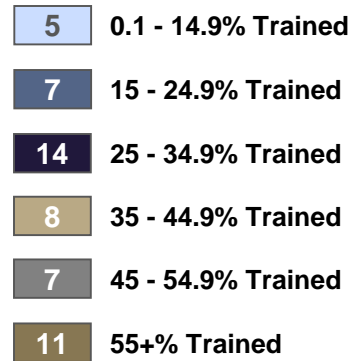
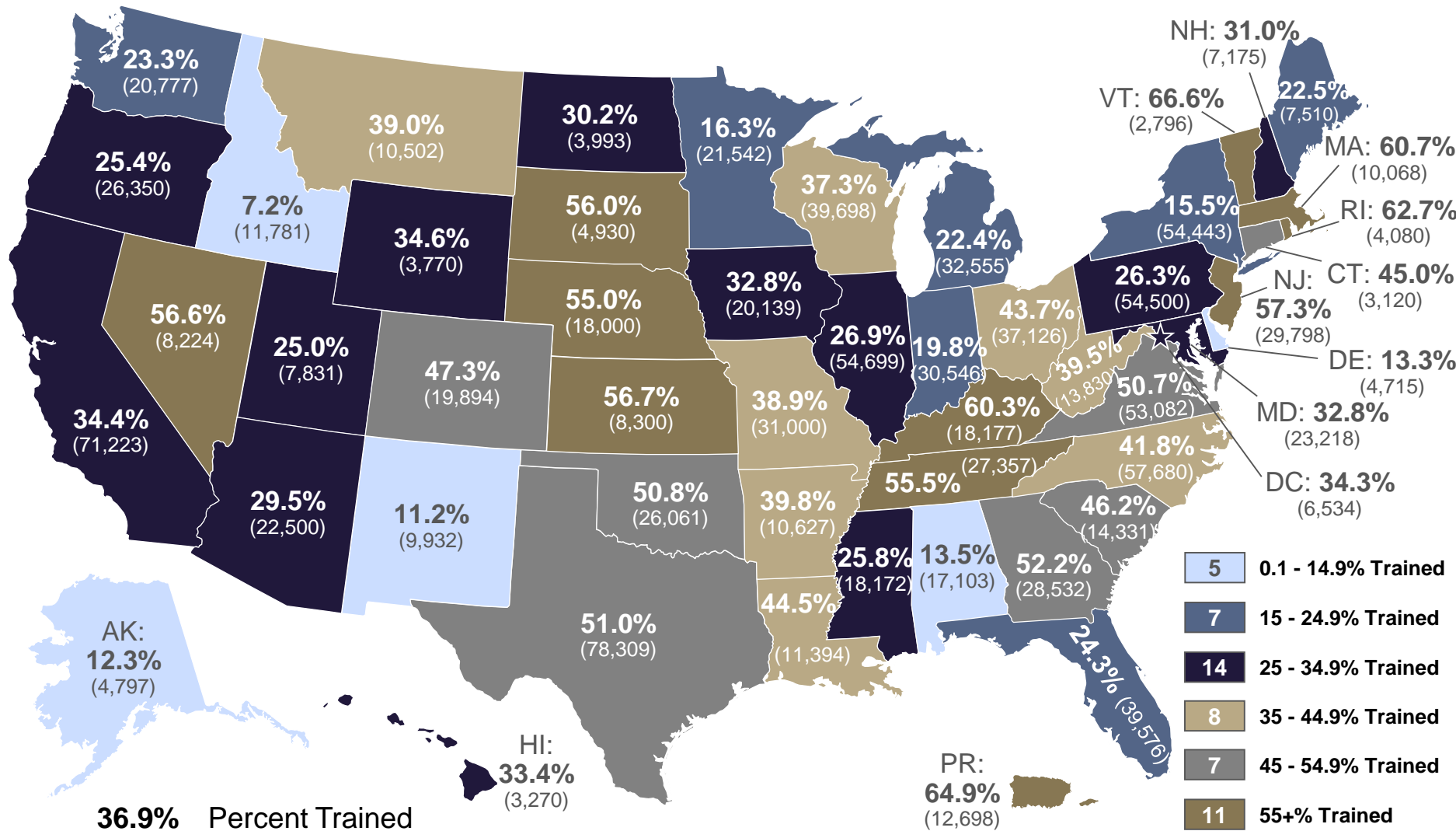
