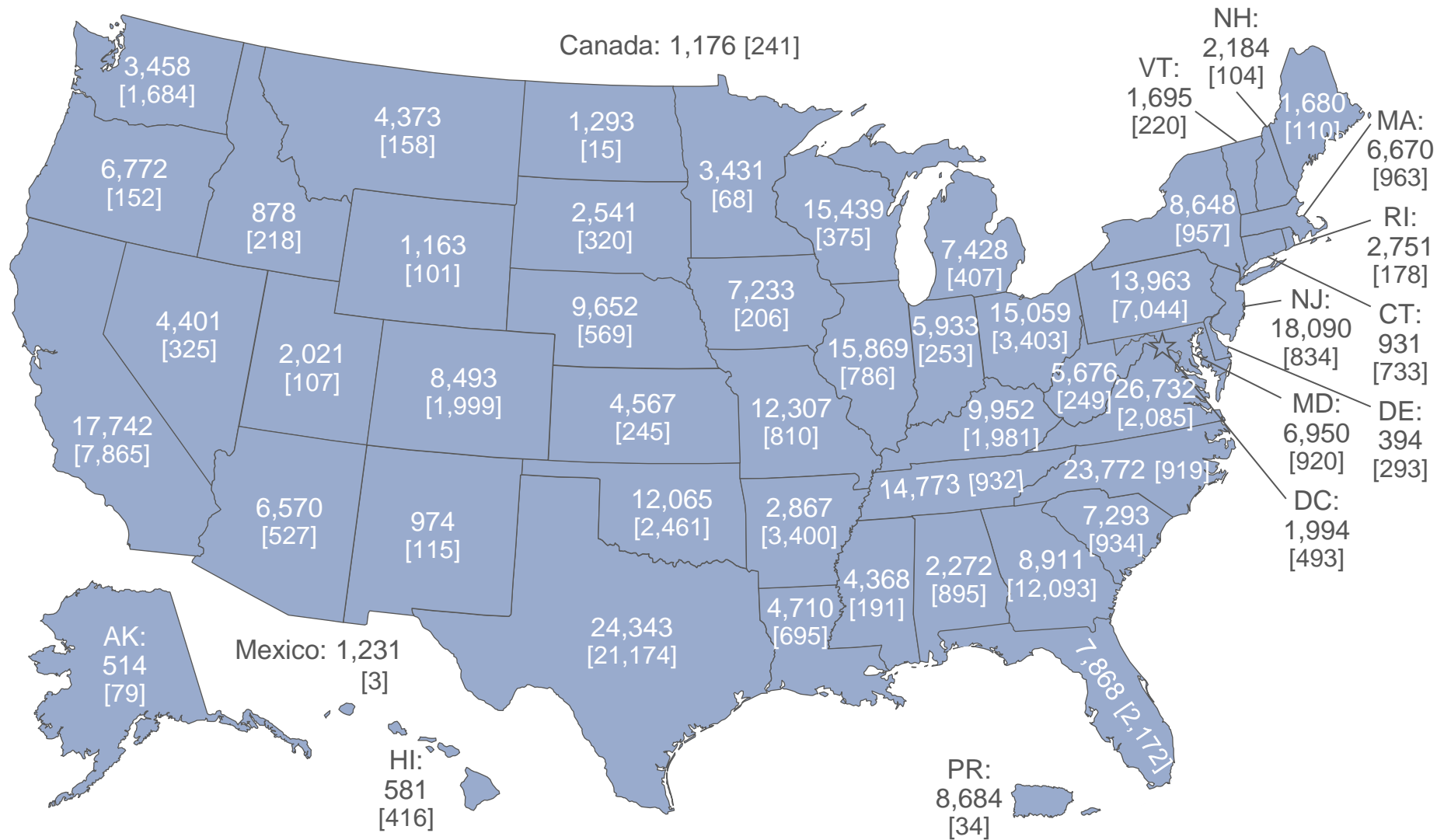

## Responder Training: In-Person & WBT

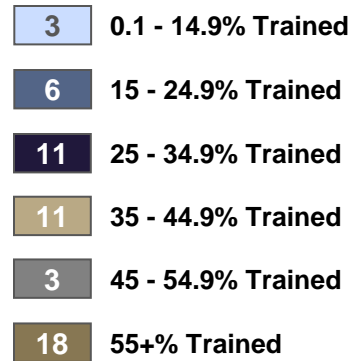
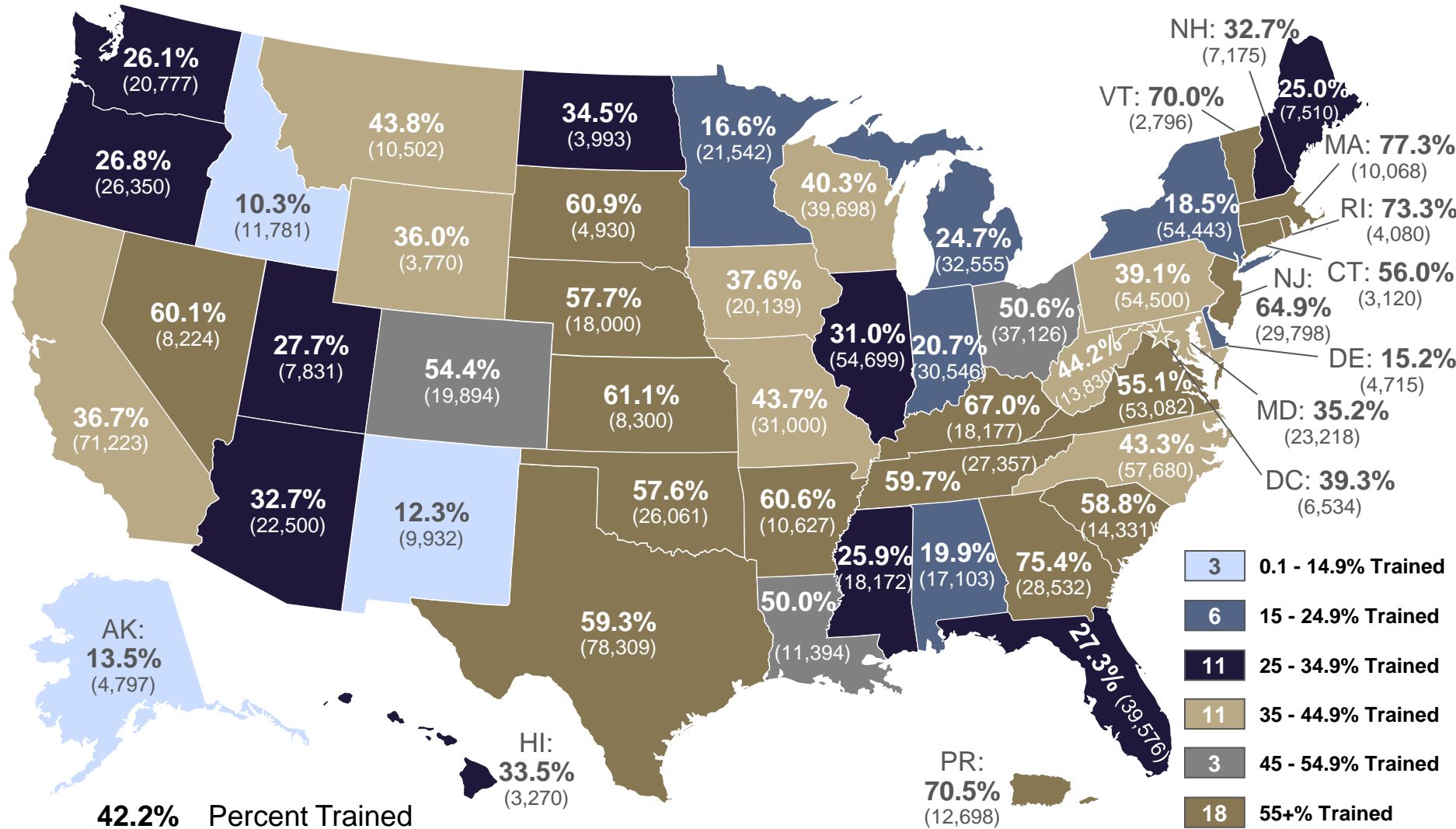
