# TCD Challenge

- TCD Challenge sponsored by TCD committee and AASHTO
- Students (high school through graduate school) prepare a pitch addressing a pre-specified topic
  - 2017 Traffic Control Devices for Connected and Automated Vehicles (CAVs)
  - 2018 Traffic Control Devices for Wrong Way Driving
- 23 submissions this year (up 50% from initial year)
- 11 finalists present their ideas in a TRB AM Poster Session
  - ► Tuesday afternoon at 2018 TRB
- Top 3 teams receive cash awards at ATSSA Traffic Expo
