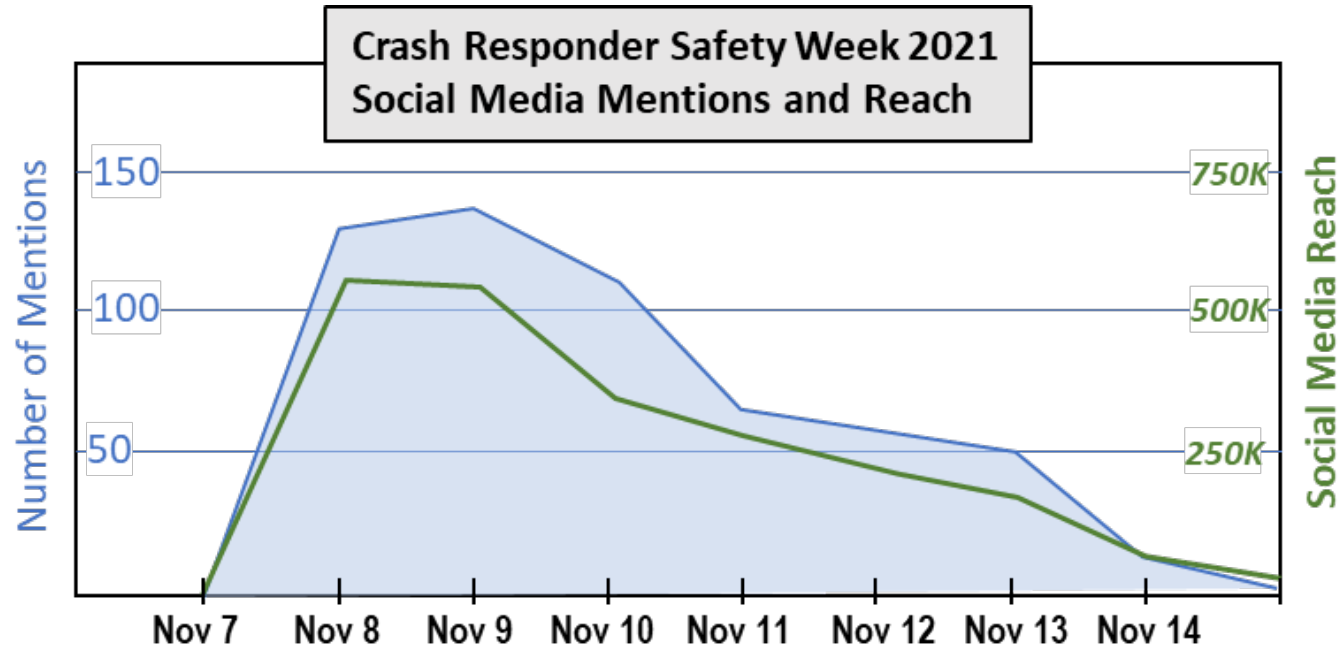

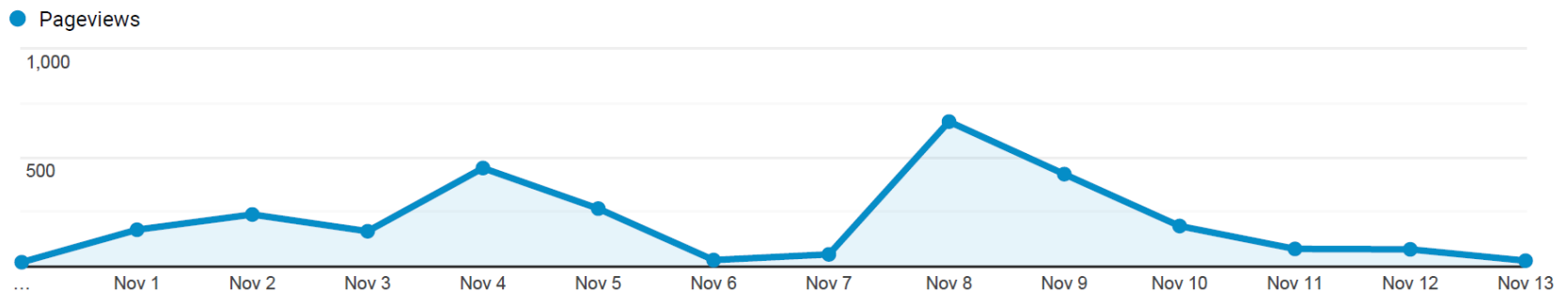
# CRSW Recap
