The Attitude

We have to approach the events as the **facilitator** not as the **host**. We are simply providing the stage for the actors to perform. Our actors are the responders that will be participating in the classes, demonstrations, and media events, all while still doing the job.

Too many times we assume that this is our show and forget to focus on the many disciplines it takes to make this happen.

What we have learned.

- 1. Pick a date and stick with it. Just because it's nice to have a high profile speaker, the focus has to be on the responders that can make it. It's nice to have elected officials speak, but the date should not keep changing to fit their calendar.
- 2. Plan on the worst case scenario, especially weather. As well attended as the event was in 2018, we estimate that it would have been twice that size had it not rained that morning. (even though Mother Nature cooperated from just before it started.)
- **3. Pick your location based on who you expect to attend.** If it's for the media, as with the Baltimore / Washington Metro Area, if you want both media markets, it has to be somewhere in between.
- 4. Don't be afraid to ask responders to travel to an event.
 We've had police, fire, and DOT from Delaware, Pennsylvania, and Virginia at each of our events.
