Responder Struck-By Fatalities SURVIVAL ALERT UPDATE

- The significant increase in the number of Responder Struck-By fatalities in 2019 as compared to 2018 is <u>alarming</u>, <u>a 129%</u> increase.
- 39 fatalities have occurred since January 1st:
 - 15 Law Enforcement Officers
 - 13 Towing & Recovery Personnel
 - 8 Firefighters/EMS Personnel
 - 3 Mobile Mechanics
 - 0 DOT/SSP
 - 0 DPW
 - 0 Other

As well as untold injuries that have yet to be reported
