- MTC (local transportation agency)
 - Issues a competitive bid contract for 28 freeway "Beats"
 - Manages all aspects of the program
- Successful Tow Contractor
 - Purchases new FSP exclusive tow trucks & required equipment
 - Hires, Employs Operators
 - Provides all Freeway Service Patrol Services
- State of California
 - CHP- Operator Training, Field oversight & Dispatch
 - Caltrans- Data collection & Reporting



Tow Contractor Responsibilities





- Disabled Vehicles
 - Fuel delivery and flat tire change
 - Attempt quick repair
 - Tow vehicle to CHP-approved safe drop site
- Vehicle Collisions
 - Clear non-injury crashes to shoulder
 - Assist with lane closure for injury crashes
- Debris removal from Roadway
 - With CHP traffic break if necessary
