In-Person Responder Training16,162 sessions with 368,902 participants





#### TIM Training Program Implementation Progress Train-the-Trainer (TtT) Sessions - As of November 10, 2019




#### TIM Training Program Implementation Progress TtT Session Participants - As of November 10, 2019



#### TIM Training Program Implementation Progress Responder Training: In-Person & WBT - As of November 10, 2019




#### TIM Training Program Implementation Progress Total Trained - As of November 10, 2019




