- 0 - Firefighter/EMS Personnel
- 3 - Law Enforcement Officers
- 0 - Towing & Recovery Personnel
- 0 - Mobile Mechanics
- 0 - DOT/SSP
- 0 – DPW

Train-the-Trainer Sessions

- 472 sessions with 12,844 participants
- 23% of participants have provided training

- 17,527 sessions with 404,393 participants

Total Trained: 510,316

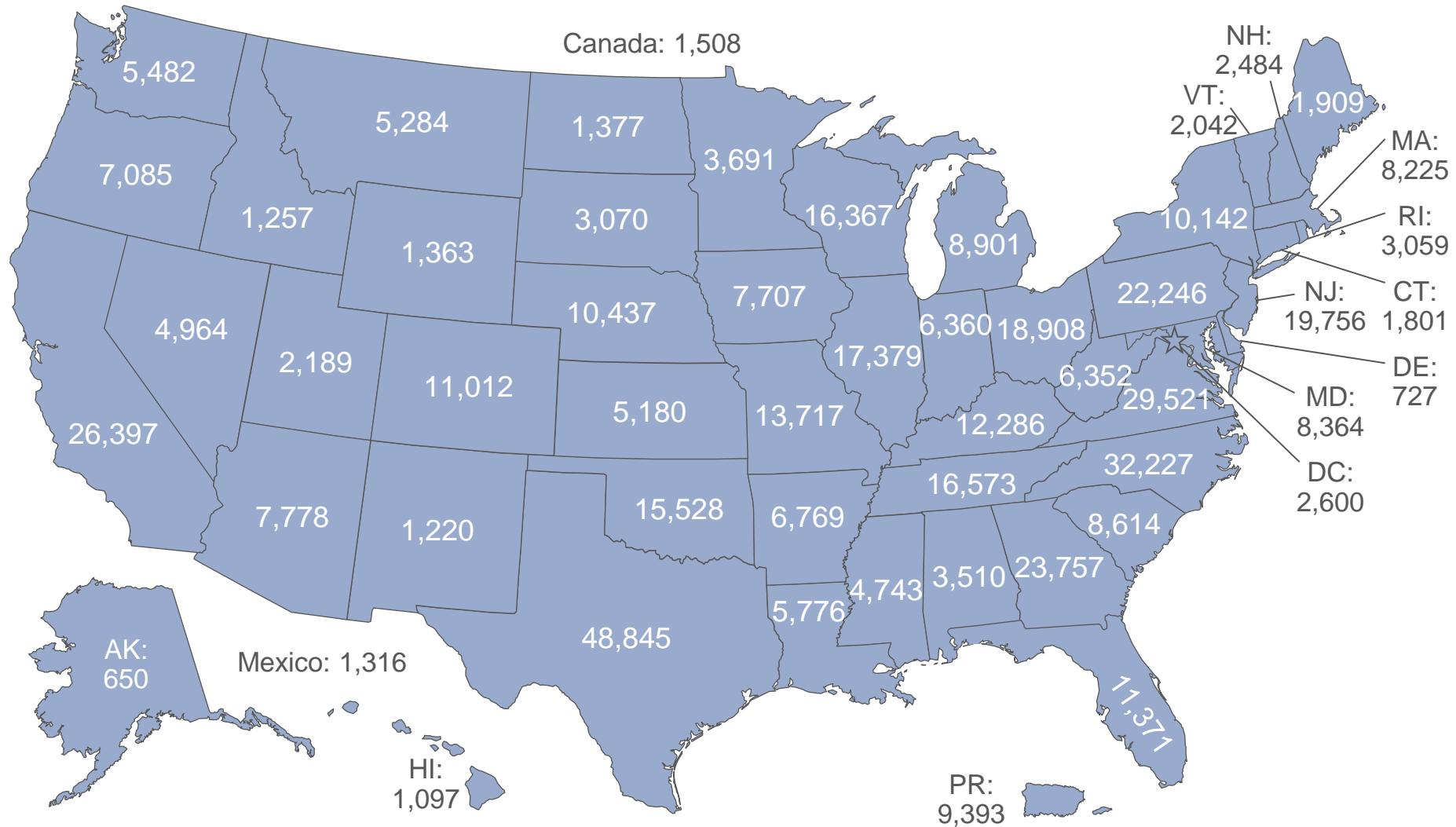
TIM Training Website

- As of January 7, 2021

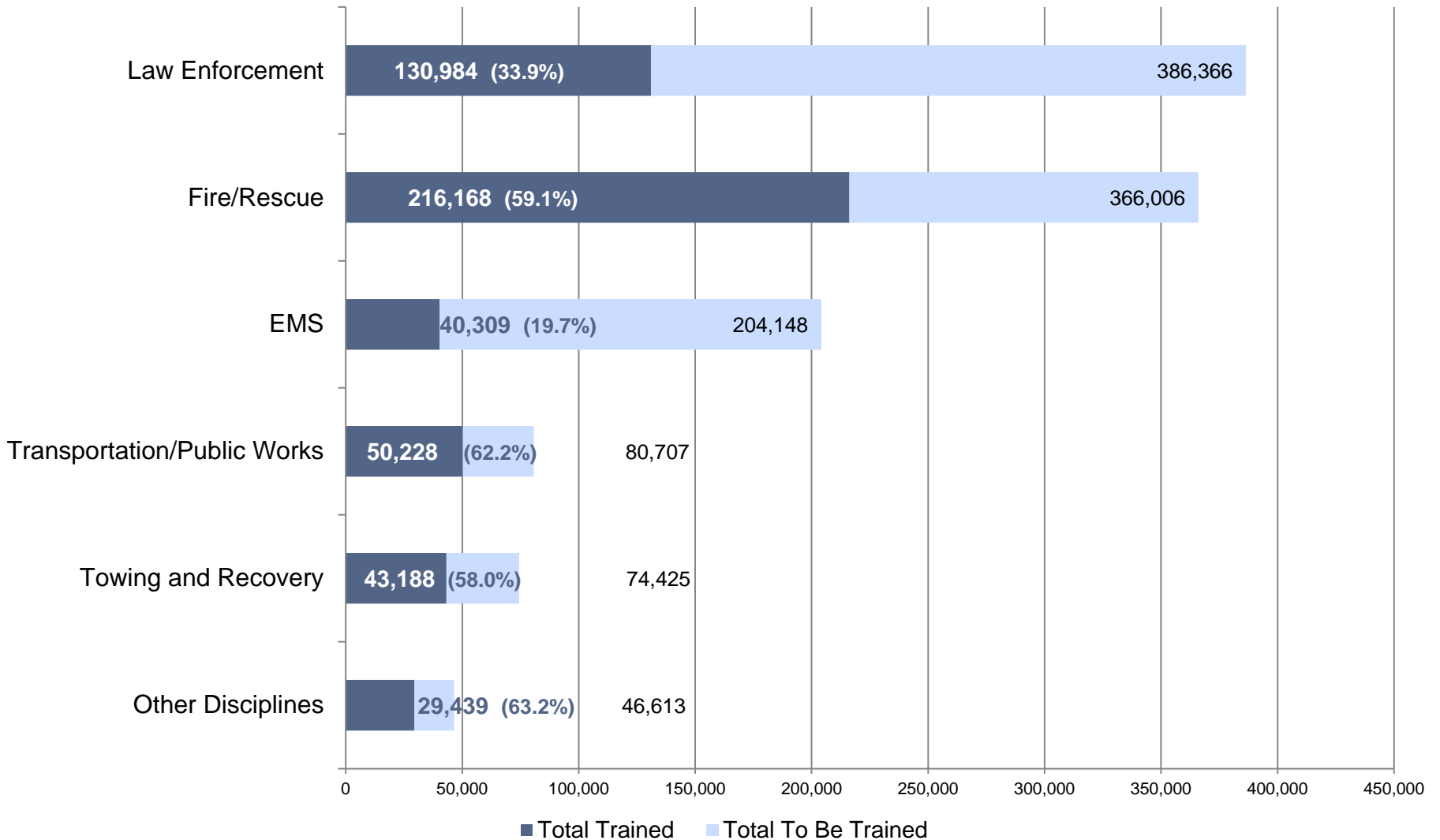
